# PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The MCWI10 series is a high-performance 10W DC-DC converter designed in an ultra-compact SIP-8 package, offering an exceptional power density of 65W/in³. Featuring an ultra-wide 4:1 input voltage range, these converters deliver fully regulated output voltages of 5.1V, 12V, 15V, 24V, ±12V, and ±15V, ensuring compatibility with a variety of industrial and embedded system applications.

Designed for demanding environments, the MCWI10 series provides 1500VDC I/O isolation, operates over a wide temperature range, and does not require a minimum load. Its very low no-load and standby power consumption make it an energy-efficient solution. Built-in under-voltage, overload, and short circuit protection enhances system reliability, while remote on/off control adds operational flexibility.

Certified to UL/cUL/IEC/EN 62368-1 safety standards, the MCWI10 series is an ideal choice for space-constrained applications requiring robust and efficient power conversion.





#### Notes

- 1 Specifications typical at Ta=+25°C, resistive load, nominal input voltage and rated output current unless otherwise noted.
- 2 Transient recovery time is measured to within 1% error band for a step change in output load of 75% to 100%.
- 3 We recommend to protect the converter by a slow blow fuse in the input supply line.
- 4 Other input and output voltage may be available, please contact MINMAX.
- 5 It is necessary to parallel a capacitor across the input pins under hot-swap operation. Minimum Capacitance:  $68\mu F/100V$  KZE.
- 6 The external components might be required to meet EMI/EMS standard for some of test items. Please contact MINMAX for the solution in detail.
- 7 Specifications are subject to change without notice.
- The repeated high voltage isolation testing of the converter can degrade isolation capability, to a lesser or greater degree depending on materials, construction, environment and reflow solder process. Any material is susceptible to eventual chemical degradation when subject to very high applied voltages thus implying that the number of tests should be strictly limited. We therefore strongly advise against repeated high voltage isolation testing, but if it is absolutely required, that the voltage be reduced by 20% from specified test voltage. Furthermore, the high voltage isolation capability after reflow solder process should be evaluated as it is applied on system.

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
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


# **Test Setup**

#### Peak-to-Peak Output Noise Measurement Test

Use a Cout 1µF ceramic capacitor. Scope measurement should be made by using a BNC socket, measurement bandwidth is 0-20 MHz. Position the load between 50 mm and 75 mm from the DC-DC Converter.





#### **Technical Notes**

#### Remote On/Off

Positive logic remote on/off turns the module on during a logic high voltage on the remote on/off pin, and off during a logic low. To turn the power module on and off, the user must supply a switch to control the voltage between the on/off terminal and the -Vin terminal. The switch can be an open collector or equivalent. A logic high is 3.5V to 12V. A logic low is 0V to 1.2 V. The maximum sink current at on/off terminal during a logic low is -500µA. The maximum allowable leakage current of the switch at on/off terminal (0V to 1.2 V) is 500µA.

#### Maximum Capacitive Load


The MCWI10 series has limitation of maximum connected capacitance at the output. The power module may be operated in current limiting mode during start-up, affecting the ramp-up and the startup time. The maximum capacitance can be found in the data sheet.

#### Overcurrent Protection

To provide protection in a fault (output overload) condition, the unit is equipped with internal current limiting circuitry and can endure current limiting for an unlimited duration. At the point of current-limit inception, the unit shifts from voltage control to current control. The unit operates normally once the output current is brought back into its specified range.


#### Input Source Impedance


The power module should be connected to a low ac-impedance input source. Highly inductive source impedances can affect the stability of the power module. In applications where power is supplied over long lines and output loading is high, it may be necessary to use a capacitor at the input to ensure startup. Capacitor mounted close to the power module helps ensure stability of the unit, it is commended to use a good quality low Equivalent Series Resistance (ESR <  $1.0\Omega$  at 100 kHz) capacitor of a  $68\mu F$  for the 12V, 24V and 48V input devices.



# Output Ripple Reduction


A good quality low ESR capacitor placed as close as practicable across the load will give the best ripple and noise performance. To reduce output ripple, it is recommended to use 1µF capacitors at the output.





#### Thermal Considerations

Many conditions affect the thermal performance of the power module, such as orientation, airflow over the module and board spacing. To avoid exceeding the maximum temperature rating of the components inside the power module, the case temperature must be kept below 105°C. The derating curves are determined from measurements obtained in a test setup.



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
